

Frequently asked questions:

How can I sign my child/ren up for CASP? (Curley After School Program)

CASP registration forms are available at both main offices, Upper School and Lower School. You may also get a copy emailed to you by getting in contact with Program Director Erika Mercado at Emercado@Bostonpublicschools.org or cellphone 857-222-0756. When the registration form is filled and your child/ren are ready to begin please email it back to the Director or you may also send it back to your child's homeroom teacher. You must have the approval of the Program Director before your child can begin the program. Please be advised that there is a one time registration fee of \$25 and the first month's parent fee due before your child can begin the program.

When are CASP parent fees due?

Parent fees are due on the 1st of each month. Payment can be made at pick up/drop off time. Please be advised that we offer a sibling discount. You pay full price for the youngest child, you get the second child ½ off. You can find our parent fees on the last page of our registration form.

Can I pick my child up before 6:00pm?

Absolutely! You may pick up your child/ren anytime between the hours of 3:00-6:00pm.

Where should I pick up my child/ren from CASP?

CASP students will always be dismissed from the Lower School entrance/exit located at 40 Pershing Rd. Our Parent Sign Out Book will be available at the door with CASP secretary Ms. Leon. For the safety of our students and staff, **PARENTS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING!!**

What are the Curley Before and After School Hours?

Before School hours are 7:00-8:15 am. (Daily fee is \$8.00 a day). Before School entrance is located in the Lower School Entrance located at 40 Pershing Rd.

After School hours are 3:00-6:00 pm. (Fees vary depending on age and days attending)

What will my child/ren do at the Curley After School Program

CASP students will participate in many different activities once they are done with homework. We offer a homework/tutoring room open from 3:30-5:30 for students who need the extra support. CASP offers Spanish Classes, Dance, Sports, Arts & Crafts, Curley Playground, Lego Club, Outdoor activities to just name a few . Our schedule changes 3 times a year to provide weather permitted activities.
